





New Digital Marketing Displays

Guardian has entered into a new agreement with truDigital, a supplier of digital lobby signage. The hardware will upgrade our current, in-store marketing monitors by enabling us to stream a variety of brand message formats. We are now able to run video, enhanced graphics and stream real-time events to lobby monitors.

Mobile Geofencing

During the fourth quarter of 2018, Guardian tested several, hyper-targeted mobile geofencing campaigns. Targeting customers who live in and visit nearby apartment complexes helps ensure that Guardian's messages will reach a key target group for storage usage. Coupon Integration

Guardian Storage has developed another unique storage industry project involving a system that automatically creates SiteLink leads for all users that claim a coupon on our website. The online coupon is a popular alternative to making a reservation for customers not ready to commit to a specific unit size prior to visiting the location. This integration offers faster communication to customers and a more streamlined workload for employees.


Social Media Bar




